**Step 1**  
Discuss with your team in what way your challenge relates to each one of the 30 human rights.

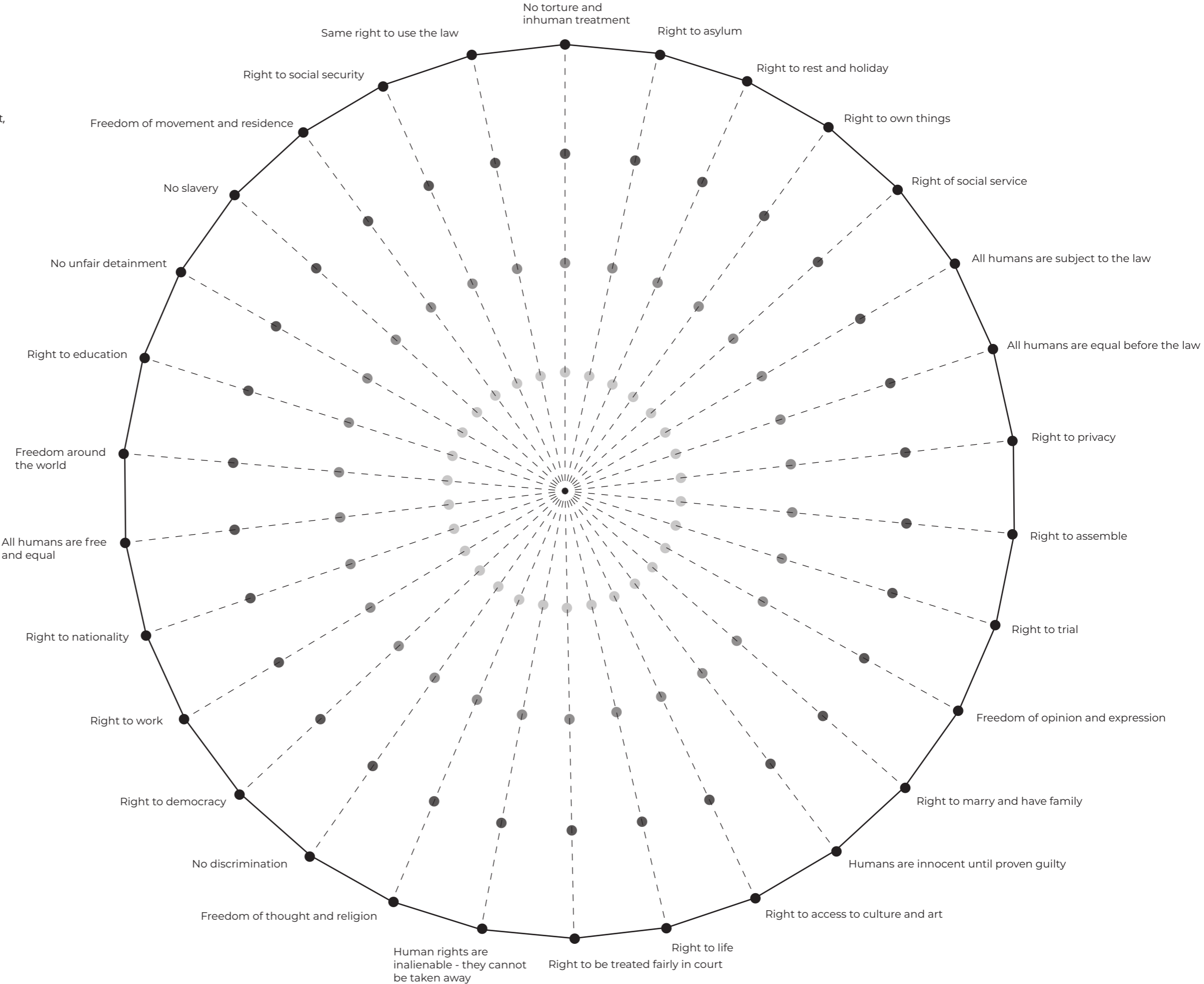
**Step 2**  
Assess to what degree your challenge relates to each of the human rights by circling the corresponding dot:

- N/A - the challenge has no relationship with this human right, there is no connection, even remotely indirect, to be found
- involvement - the challenge is related to this human right to a small degree, yet there is a connection
- contribution - the challenge is related to this human right to some degree yet not directly
- direct influence - the challenge is strongly related to this human right and the connection is evident

Connect the dots you circled, drawing a spiderweb.

**Step 4**  
Reflect. What does this spiderweb tell you about the relationship between your challenge and the human rights? What have you learned about the human rights? Are there any human rights that you did not consider before? Are there some that you would like to focus on more?

- contribution - the solution is related to this human right to some degree yet not directly
- direct influence - the challenge is strongly related to this human right and the connection is evident
